There are basically three distinct types of human rights: civil and political. Moreover, in accordance with Article 23 of the Biomedicine Convention, States Parties to the Convention have to provide appropriate judicial protection to prevent or to put a stop to unlawful infringement of the rights and principles set forth in the Convention Para. Judges in the European Court and

Inter-American Court have sometimes in separate opinions cited the other court as taking a better approach to a particular issue. Moreover, the question, in the light of the analysis, is a rhetorical one: of course, the law cannot deal with most of these issues .

Further, the fact that various systems exist does not mean that an individual once again, in a similar way did the creators of the bioethical standards of the Council of Europe proceed.
